
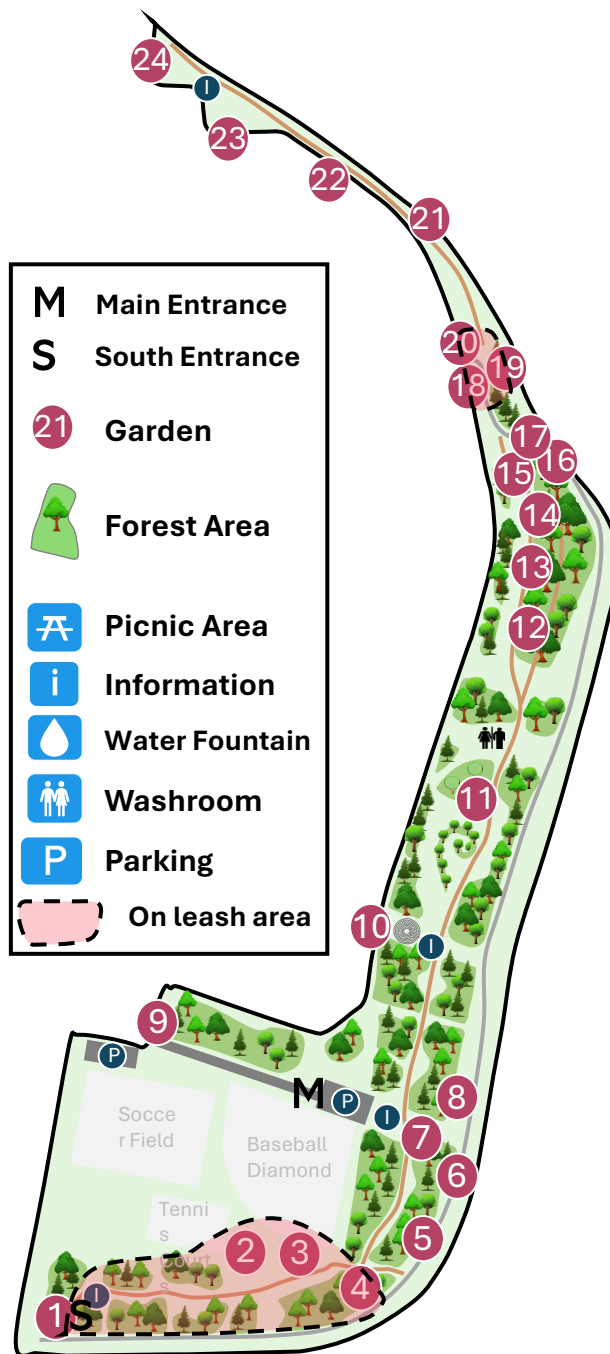


HISTORY

In 2002, 7000 trees were planted as part of the birthplace forest initiative. In 2007, a group of community volunteers developed the Oval Garden. Since that time the garden area has increased to include 21 individual gardens showcasing the variety of plants that grow in Calgary's unique climate.
